

# COMMUNITY BENEFIT

**FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING 9/30/2022**

The Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act contains a provision for Tampa General Hospital (TGH) to issue a financial report on the level of community benefit the hospital provides each year. Below is our community benefit report for the 2022 fiscal year.

**Community Benefit is defined as:**

- Charity care and other financial assistance on behalf of uninsured and low-income people
- Subsidized health services
- Financial and in-kind contributions to local charities
- Health professions education
- Research
- Community health improvement

*As part of its overall community benefit, TGH annually provides almost \$1 million to other community not-for-profit organizations, and more than \$3 million to community health improvement and community benefit operations.*
