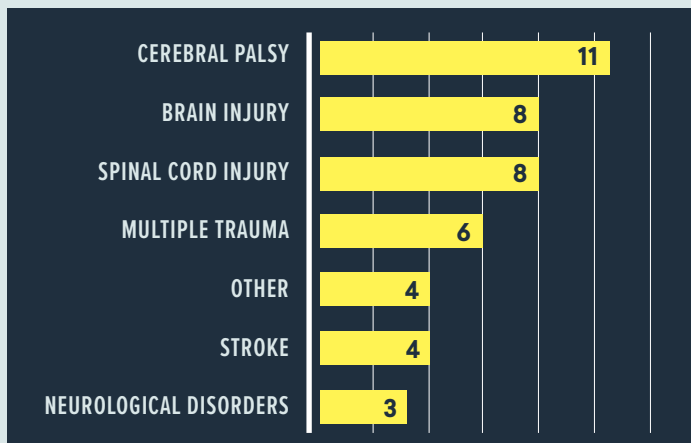

## MEASURING IMPROVEMENT



We assess patient improvements with the Functional Independence Measure (WeeFIM). The higher the score the better. From admission to discharge, and over a shorter stay in the hospital, the average gain in scores was:

**TGH: 21.3 points of change**

**Nationally: 21.9 points of change**

## SATISFACTION AND PATIENT EXPERIENCE



- **96%** of patient/caregivers rate the care “good” or “excellent,” the two highest categories.
- **100%** would return.
- **100%** of caregivers report we met their education/training needs to care for their child at home.

## DISCHARGED TO HOME/COMMUNITY



TGH Home Discharge Rate: **97.6%**

(2.4% required extra medical care at an acute facility prior to discharge)

National Home Discharge Rate: **89.9%**
